# Karisma

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## Karisma

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A mirror held up to the world, exposing the aspects of life we often forget or ignore — lies, hatred, energy, connection — this is the work of the secretive artist known only as Karisma. Born in Varese, Italy, Karisma turned to art for a more personal reason than fame or fortune; his work is the result of sleepless nights and struggles with depression.

Karisma is a self-taught digital artist, garnering attention from magazines and award competitions early in his career. Though discreet about his artistic process, Karisma has exhibited work at the International Exhibition of Modern and Contemporary Art in Innsbruck, Austria. Audiences are drawn to the raw and even cruel energy that permeates

his work.

Karisma cites no influences upon his work, drawing solely upon his own mind for the often dark, challenging, and thrilling scenes within his art, such as those seen in his We Bleed Watercolors (2019) collection. Today Karisma continues to explore the corners of his inner world while living and working in Italy.

Some art seeks to please you — my work makes no such promise. I use my artwork to construct a window into modern society, giving viewers the chance to see with clear eyes both the darkness and the energy that flows through our world.



## Karisma

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My art is meant to challenge the viewer, to invite them to peer through the window I create and experience the conflicting emotions that may arise. Some viewers are upset by what they find in my work, while others are startled at the raw expression, even claiming that, like Paganini, I may have sold my soul to offer such a clear window into the world.

I avoid seeking influences for my work that exist outside my own mind; it's my mind that brought me to first create art as a remedy for soothing the sting of depression.

My art is the voice that I could find no ears for; I put my conflicts and thoughts into my work and let them speak for themselves. I keep my practice private, no longer using my words to explain my inner world, but letting my art speak for me instead.

I welcome viewers to enter that inner world through my art and allow themselves to be challenged by what they find — a mirror to our world that reminds us of that which we would often rather ignore.



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

I was fascinated by the feeling of creating from "nothing" and achieving a similar result to what my eyes saw.

In my adolescence I managed to appreciate art beyond aesthetics, and I used it as a means to relieve the pain of a mourning, my perspective was expanded and I also experienced it as a means of expression and communication, as an

emotional language that allowed me to feel listened to and relieved. It was at this stage that I had the opportunity to take drawing, painting and sculpture workshops, so I learned to handle different materials such as graphite, charcoal, pastels, acrylic, oil and clay.

I studied Bachelor and Master's in psychology. During this period, I designed and implemented an artistic creativity workshop for children with outstanding abilities. After a couple of years, I returned to the arts as a full-time profession and my instruction through courses, workshops and specialized diplomas in hyper-realistic drawing and painting, as well as some techniques of baroque painting.



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

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Cecilia Djk was born in Paris suburb on the 16th of June, in 1993 in France. committed Artist, drawing, painting and writing are her main sources of expression. At 17 years-old, she published her first novel and enter fine arts school at 19 years-old. Facing financial issues, she decides to shorten her studies and to continue her art research and work on her own. in 2015, a traumatic event leads her to change her name and she uses it for her artist name, Cecilia DJK. Hyper sensitive, she is highly engaged and committed to human, social and environment cause.

Between 20 and 24. her work is very dark (Black and white paintings), following the path of the German expressionists of year 30 as it always impressed her. She uses her dark mood and trauma to express forms and landscapes (particularly architecture) very unbuilt, broken or impossible. The notion of what is reel and unreel become an obsession in this work. As she is interested in Freud and the Dada movement, she follows her work by trying to find particular process, such as emotional moment or cadavre exquis technic. This work and process research give birth to a new type of work which she calls accumulation. According to the artist, Accumulation of memory, accumulation of forms. accumulation of dreams, each accumulation possibility with a part of questioning about reality becomes a treasure.



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The flashy colors and drawing style very narrative (childish sometimes) yet inflammatory and daring is addressed to opening minds with an interest for modern and contemporary art. My multiples trips allow me to have this fountain of inspiration and a progressive style rich in culture.

From 24 to 27, the artist follow a new path and work on accumulation with Artist excessive colors and very flash as Pop art artists would use. "Dream and unconsciousness are notions which have always been a part of me and my work.

Through my writings, drawings and paintings, a philosophic notion of questioning about reality allow the audience to escape and appropriate another ephemeral reality for the time of an exhibition, a moment." These openings and lightness enroll her work in a special consistent line of drive.


Multicultural influences as African. Asian and south American can be found within her paintings. Dadaism and Surrealism are mainly influencing it and the artist is very interested at contemporary youth and its excesses and drifts, expressing it with themes as inequality between men and women, the loss of identity and values within a youth struggling to find their place. As a lot of Artist, she has the feeling not every people can grow their selfdevelopment in a case chosen for them by society. "I step for the youth given up and misunderstood and intend to denounce and inform with my work". Grouping generations and opening the debate is the main purpose of Cecilia DJK accumulation work.

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Sam Heydt (born April 20, 1986) is an American social practice and recycled media artist born/raised in New York City. Although currently residing in Vienna, Heydt has lived/worked in Paris, Venice, Amsterdam, Athens, Buenos Aires, Sydney, Reykjavík and Rajasthan. Her academic career traversed Parsons School of Design, The New School, Cooper Union, University of Amsterdam, Universitdad of Buenos Aires and La Sorbonne. In 2012, Heydt launched Jane Street Studio, L.L.C. in Manhattan. Since established, the photo studio has broadened its performance to provide both design and marketing consultation in addition to art direction. It's growing roster of clients span Europe, North & South America, Asia and Oceania.



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In addition to this entrepreneurial undertaking, Heydt has attended artist residencies in Iceland, Australia and New Zealand; where she has documented different forms of environmental exploitation. A published author, producer and lifelong activist, Heydt has undertaken a range of altruistic, non-profit work. Her art, anchored in social advocacy, attempts to give a voice to the veiled, forgotten, exiled, and silenced.





In her practice, she works across a spectrum of different media- film, video, installation, photography, sculpture, sound, merchandize, text — and employs a range of materials often reinventing or trespassing their associative use. Heydts' vision looks beyond the ordinary. Esteemed as one of the pioneers of the recycled media movement, Heydt's work has been shown in galleries, museums, art fairs and film festivals worldwide

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The edge is closer than we think, but illusion won't free us from reality, even as the sustained narrative of tabloids becomes history and he myth of progress continues to perpetuate inequality. As the natural world is liquidated and substitutes with an artificial one, public discourse is being defined by even narrower bandwidths. While social processes defy the logic of individualism in global capitalism, the underbelly of profitability fueling globalization emerges as exploitation.

In a time marked by mass extinction, product fetishism, diminishing resources, and patented seeds, we find ourselves in a world exploited beyond use, a world increasingly reduced to a bottom line. Concerns for which are drowned out by the white noise of the media and the empty promises it proposes for the future it truncates.

Working across different media- film, video, installation, photography, sculpture, sound and text, Heydt presents an abstract proposition for a world on the periphery of history, one that not only appears haunted by the ghosts of the past, but built on it. Heydt's layered imagery conflate time and place, colliding and merging generations of possibilities, and disrupting logical relationships between occurrences. Combining images of destruction with portrayals of the virtues born from the American Dream, Heydt confronts the disillusionment of our time with the ecological and existential nightmare it is responsible for.


